The aim of the Scholarship Programme is to assist the successful individuals, who might otherwise not have all of the necessary resources at present, to achieve a commercial Licence. These scholarships require the successful candidates to pay just 25% (£712.00) of the retail cost of the package as a pledge of commitment to complete the course. This payment will be made directly to BGS within three months of the award.

What IS included:

- ATPdigital CBT software – available on Mac, iPad or Windows computers.
- 3 x 5 days revision teaching – online or in-person (at the Clevedon, UK training centre) – 1 week (5 continuous working days) per module.
- 18-month subscription to BGS Video Library (recorded ATPL videos).
- 12-month Bristol Question Bank – BGSONline (the subscription starts from the date of course enrolment).
- Downloadable example aircraft data booklets (CAP696, CAP697 & CAP698).
- Support from world-class instructors.
- Technical software support throughout studies.

What IS NOT included and will need budgeting for:

- ATPL exam fees (each exam authority sets their own price).
- Ring bound or bound manuals (these will be available to purchase separately if required).
- A Jeppesen Airway Manual – GSPRM.
- A CRP-5 navigation computer.
- A commercial navigation protractor.
- A precision drawing set.
- An exam-approved calculator.
- A printed set of example aircraft data booklets (CAPs).
- Costs (including shipping) for any additional printed material that is required.

- Transport and accommodation for the revision courses at Bristol if attending in person.



THE CRITERIA FOR SUCCESSFUL APPLICATIONS ALSO INCLUDES:

- You **must** provide with your application, a valid copy of your Class 1 Medical Certificate issued in the UK in accordance with Part Med.
- You **must** provide a copy of your PPL licence with a valid SEP rating issued to International Civil Organisation (ICAO) standards.
- You **must** be aged at least 18 years old as of the closing date and be a UK permanent resident.
