Honourable Company of Air Pilots Gliding Scholarship 2021



In August 2021 I was lucky enough to complete a five-day residential gliding course at Derby and Lancashire Gliding Club, awarded to me by the Honourable Company of Air Pilots. On Thursday we managed to get back into the air where we could put this practice into action. Luckily on Friday, the weather was perfect for



gliding, so I managed to get a total of 6 winch launches. By the end of the week, I was able to take off and land the glider with only a bit of assistance.
