that lasted nearly 40-minutes. He taught me so many things. I was already practising landing on the second day. He performed and taught me numerous manoeuvres while we were in the air, including circuits, stalling, turning, landing, and even winch launch failures. It was incredible.

On the penultimate day, I requested some winch launch fails, which was the most exhilarating thing I've ever done.

When the cable was pulled, we had to point the nose downwards, which felt like a funfair ride - I'll admit, the first time I had to refrain myself from screaming.
